Educate Me Foundation is a registered non-profit foundation that aspires to redefine education in Egypt through a progressive skill- based, learner-centered education model while promoting a culture of lifelong learning.

#### Why we're here

#### The challenge

Underprivileged children in Egypt do not get equal opportunity to quality education either by not having access to education (in marginalized areas) or receiving poor quality of education due to the challenges in the public education system that include:

- → Teacher child ratio
- → Teacher-centric learning approach
- → Focus on Academic achievement and ignoring all other aspects of child development
- → Teacher-child ratio. Currently some governorates reach 69 students per class due to a shortage in teachers and hire freeze by the government since 1998
- → Violence and unsafe learning environment
- → Focus on teaching content rather than using it as context to enhance lifelong learning skills critical for students to keep up with an everchanging world.



## What's missing

#### The market gap

Egypt is currently undergoing an education reform with a new curriculum launched that is more skill-based and has a student-centered approach to learning yet there are still challenges in gaining educators' buy-in for the change/reform. This coupled with the lack of contextualized professional development programs for public school educators who face challenges of overcrowded classrooms, limited infrastructure, resources are scarce and a shortage of teachers due to the freezing of hiring by the ministry. This resulted in poor quality of education in public schools and the goal of the education process is passing the test rather than learning.



#### What is needed

#### The solution

We believe that the only realistic model of success requires contextualized local solutions and ownership that can translate to enhanced teaching and hence, better learner outcomes. And therefore Educate Me worked in two parallel paths

- 1) A community school model that aims to provide quality education to underprivileged students and acts as our "center of excellence"
- 2) Professional Development programs for public schools that aims to enhance teaching and thus students learning outcomes



All our programs are **contextualized** to the needs of the education system in Egypt, with all the challenges and current gaps.

# What is our methodology Unique approach

All our programs are **evidence based**, employing several tools that secure internal data to improve further, achieving the desired outcomes and allowing for effective scaling.

All our programs offer **practical** and hands-on experience to beneficiaries through follow up, coaching and mentorship.

**Sustainability** is a key component of all our programs through empowering the community and agents of change.

We apply a **Humanistic approach** to learning and therefore, educators' wellbeing is a core element.

#### How we plan to do that

To be able to achieve its vision, Educate Me has developed a 10-year strategy with the support of KiVU international, funded by the British embassy. Accordingly, we identified five strategic priorities we must address over the coming year:



**Priority 1:** Directly deliver a quality education to children at Educate Me Foundation (community) Schools.



**Priority 2:** To deliver high quality professional development to teachers and school leaders in Educate Me's partner public schools.



**Priority 3:** Strengthen research capacity and influence.



**Priority 4:** Increase influence on policy, through a more strategic and proactive approach in communications and stakeholder relationships, with government and key education influencers.



**Priority 5:** Sustainable funding Model.



# Our programs at a glance







To provide a high-quality education to students in Educate Me Community Schools



To demonstrate a widely replicable model of high-quality education at public school funding levels through optimizing the cost/child



To scale up provision over a 5-year period, both in terms of numbers of children and numbers of schools

# **Community Schools**



Established in 2015, Educate Me Community Schools grant the primary stage government certificate while following a skill based, learner-centered education model that focuses on whole-child development. The school is located on the periphery of the under-resourced district of Talbeya, where we also operate an early learning center serving children aged 4 to 6 employing our wholly owned learner-centered model. With a total number of 21 facilitators and 13 Administration and management team, we are currently serving a total of 432 students.

In order to create a sustaible model, community ownership and engagement is crucial. Educate Me works on several interventions to ensure community engagement and empowerement. This includes:



Hiring 75% of the staff from the community



Empowering teachers and staff through continuously building their capacities



Delivering awarness sessions to parents to ensure holistic child development



Creating several channels of commnication with parents such as a Board of trustees, a facebook community, etc,...



The school uses several evaluation tools to track the development, progress and development needs for each student and surveys to measure retention and parents' satisfaction. Every year we carry a baseline and endline assessment to measure our main success KPIs which are Literacy Skills, Numeracy skills, and Social Emotional learning (SEL) improvement rates. The assessments are done using international- ly accredited tools EGRA & EGMA for "Literacy and Numeracy" and IDLEA for SEL and ISELA.

Social Emotional Learning "SEL" is essential for learning to happen. Therefore, we at Educate Me School, focus on SEL as much as we do for other skills and academic achievement - including Numeracy and Literacy skills as foundations to learning away from academic achievement.

# School Transformation Journey

Educate Me launched the School Transformation Journey (STJ), in an attempt to transform public schools into lifelong learning hubs'. The STJ program is a three years school-based reform; targeting all school team to ensure institutional development rather than individual development. This aims to accelerate change through creating a common language and alignment of vision between the school staff.

# Blended Learning Journey

The COVID-19 crisis caused a major disruption in education globally that led to a sharp and sudden transition from traditional, face-to-face education to distance learning education. But the challenge is public school educators in Egypt are not equipped with the necessary skills and qualifications needed for this transformation and no plans will succeed unless we build the capacities of the educators who are the main drivers of the educational process. Therefore, arising from this gap, Educate Me launched the blended learning program that aims to both create a mindset shift on use of technology in Education and build the capacity of teachers for basic blended learning skills and then build the capacity of the digital team which will act as digital literacy team within their schools. The program result to date show its effectiveness in creating a mindset shift towards the importance of use of technology in education to create an interactive learning environment inside the classroom and remotely.

# Public School Students Programs

### **Student Camps**

In public schools, curriculum tends to focus primarily on external forms of knowing and being while students' inner dimensions are often ignored. In the clamor for standardization and higher test scores there is little talk about imagination, emotions, self-actualization, joy, exploration, or imagination. Education is thus seen as a process of depositing knowledge into passive students. It emphasizes teacher-centric learning where students are passive absorbers of information and that the purpose of learning is memorization of facts.

Arising from a different educational paradigm whereby students are perceived as active change agents in their learning and development with teachers as facilitators and that 21st century students need to be actively engaged in the learning process, Educate Me developed a 3-Day Project based learning camp.

The Objective of the camp is to nurture 21st century skills and values through a project-based learning-method in a safe and stimulating environment, and through fun activities and methods.



#### **Educational Games**

During COVID, Educate Me launched its first educational game "Ta7ady el remal"; an educational board game inspired by our Student Camp to engage students, enhance learning, and enhance cooperation and communication skills. The game targets public schools' children between 10 and 14 years old.

#### The game aims to:

- Increase knowledge.
   Children learn about Egypt by focusing on ten governorates locations, monuments, famous characters, and the handicrafts they are famous for.
- 2. Enhance skills and values

The game works on children's ability to express themselves (Love and Pride), their collaboration skills, and their sense of responsibility (Perseverance).

# International Programs Adaptation

#### **Teaching at The Right Level**

Educate Me Me partnered with Pratham foundation to bring TARL to Egypt through contextualizing the program and conducting a pilot in Egypt and the first of it's kind in the Middle East. The program aims to enhance basic literacy and numeracy skills for students who lack basic literacy & numeracy skills, through an activity-based and play-based approach. The pilot was implemented in 58 public and community schools in 4 governorates, impacting more than 8707 public school students. The program was successful in enhancing literacy and numeracy skills for the target beneficiaries in 40 days.

Educate Me plans to continue delivering TARL in more schools both public and community schools and aims to scale it nationwide.



# We aspire to create Systemic Change in the education system in Egypt

Educate Me aims to scale its programs nationwide to drive wider change in the national system of teacher professional development. This will be done through a focus on:

- → Increasing our direct delivery of the programs in more governorates and different geographical contexts
- → Running impact evaluations to validate the model in terms of scalability and sustainability.
- → Adopting a more strategic and proactive approach to communications and stakeholder relationships, with government and key education influencers
